Bowling Green State University's College of Musical Arts has earned a reputation as one of the country's outstanding collegiate music programs. Undergraduate through doctoral degree programs prepare talented musicians for professional careers in performance, teaching, composition, and musical scholarship. Approximately 300 undergraduate and 150 graduate students have opportunities to learn and grow under the guidance of nearly 60 distinguished full-time faculty members.

Each year women from around the campus come together to form the University Women's Chorus, an ensemble specializing in the vast choral repertoire composed for treble voices. The chorus performs both on and off campus, and has performed at several professional conferences.
